

OVER its thirty-three conferences since 1987, St Michael's has formed a vibrant community within the Anglican Church in the Maritimes. It remains committed to worshipping, studying, playing, and adventuring together as members of the family of God.

Our conference participants—or Michaelites!—don't do things by half measures. When we worship, we worship God reverently in spirit and truth. When we study, we challenge ourselves to learn deeply. When we kick back for games and activities, we make sure that we have a blast. This “all in” attitude grows our faith and builds long-lasting friendships.



What will we do?

St Mike's has three pillars: prayer, study, and play.

WE PRAY TOGETHER three times a day, at Morning Prayer, Evensong, and Compline. We use the *Book of Common Prayer*, valuing it as the greatest treasure we receive from the Anglican tradition, and as our link to ancient forms of catholic worship.

Each morning we participate in three courses, as we seek to understand God and his church more deeply. This year, the three courses on offer will be about the person of Jesus (**Theology**), the nature of the Bible and its role in our lives (**Scripture**), and the Anglican tradition of public worship (**Spirituality**).

We fill our afternoons and evenings with on-site and off-site games and activities, including a canoe trip, campfires, and water games.
